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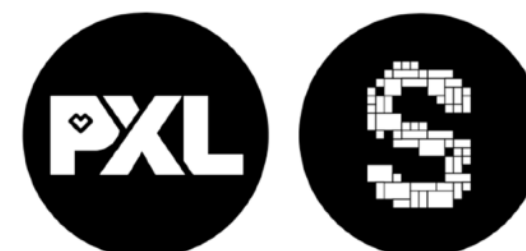

Interviewing

This booklet will help you to record an audio interview on your smartphone.

Voice Record Pro works on iOS and Android devices.

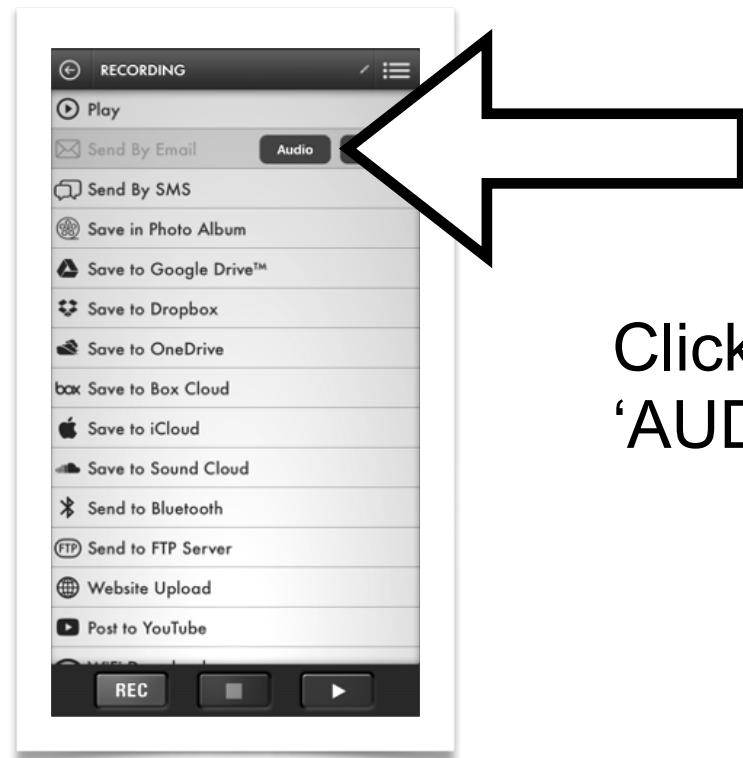
After making your recording, this booklet will show you how to share the file via e-mail, Google Drive, Dropbox, OneDrive, iCloud...



For other options, like Dropbox & Google Drive, click 'save' and log in to your account.

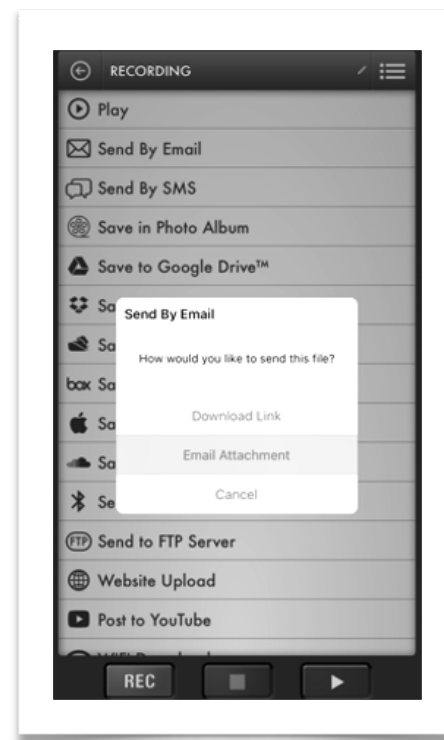


Congratulations! You've just completed and shared your first-ever interview!



Click on 'Send By Email' and then 'AUDIO'

Click on "Email Attachment". The mail app on your device will open.



Please enter the E-Mail address to where you want to send the recording to.

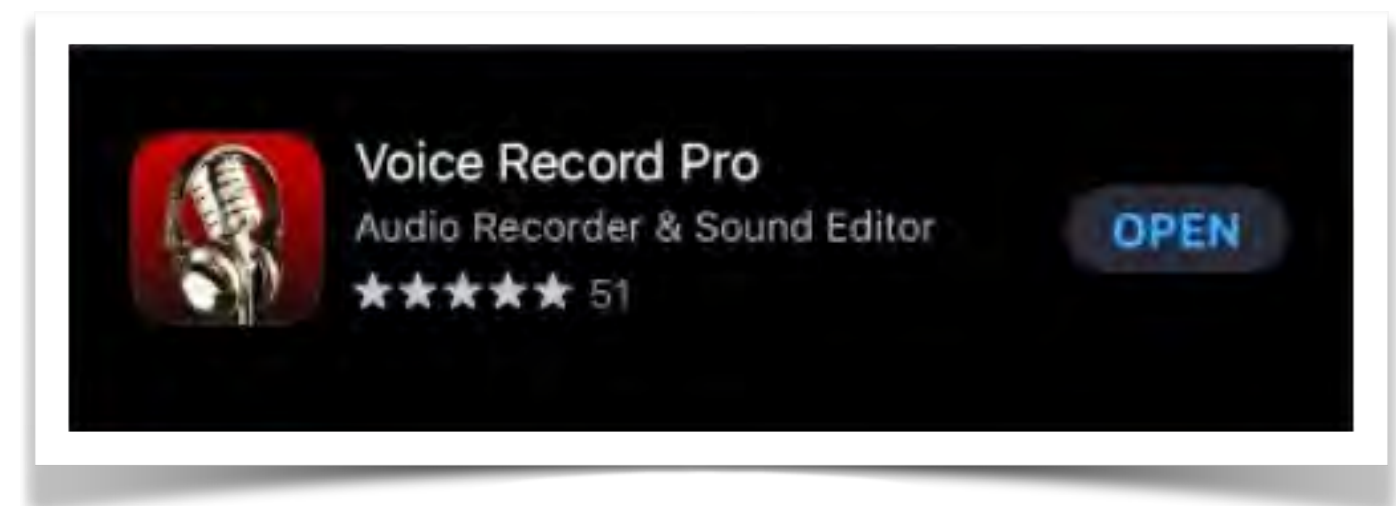
Click send.

Download Voice Record Pro

Go to the Apple APP STORE or



- Search for "Voice Record Pro."
- Click to download
- Wait until the download is completed
- Click open 'Voice Record Pro'



Start Voice Record Pro

When first opening the app, it will ask you for access to the microphone.

Please confirm these necessary steps.

When you see this screen, click 'Next'.



Check if you see the 'home screen' of the app



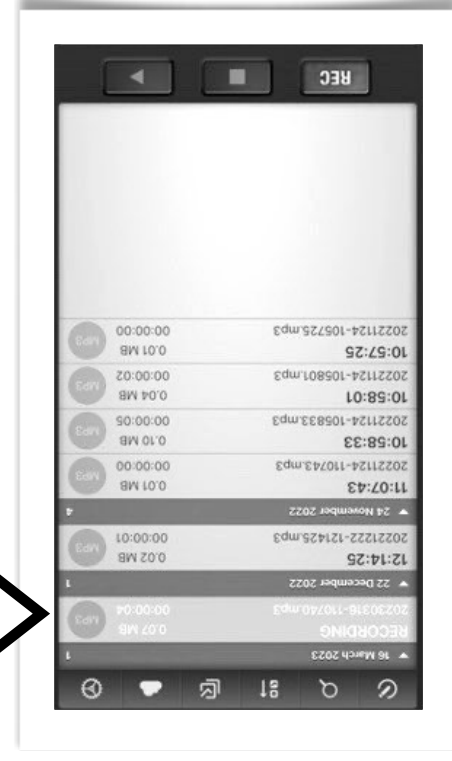
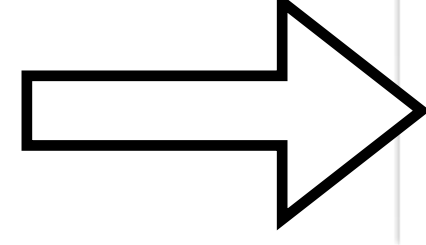
Share your interview with the world

Choose how you wish to share your recording. We'll use e-Mail as an example



When finished, click the little checkmark in the top right

Click on the recording you wish to share



Stop the recording & change the file name

After stopping recording you will see the file on the home screen. Click on its name.




Click the tiny pencil on the top right of the screen.


You can now type a new name for your recording

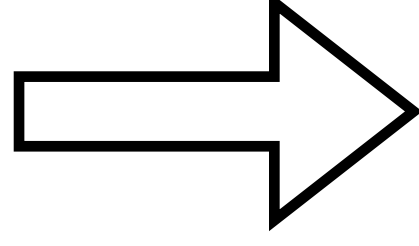
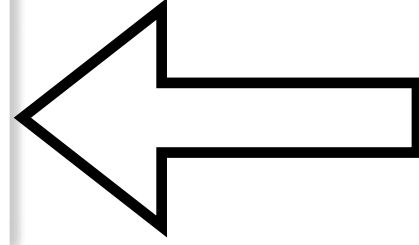
Change the audio format

Change the audio format to MP3

- MP3 is the easiest audio to work with and to share your recordings
- Click the settings icon

• Click 'Recording'



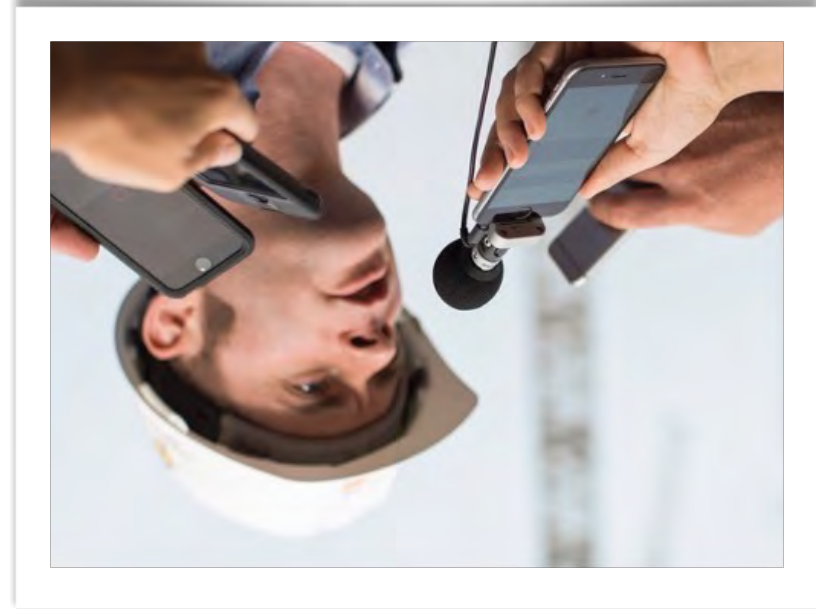
Recording the interview

Pay attention to where the microphone is located on your iPhone or iPad

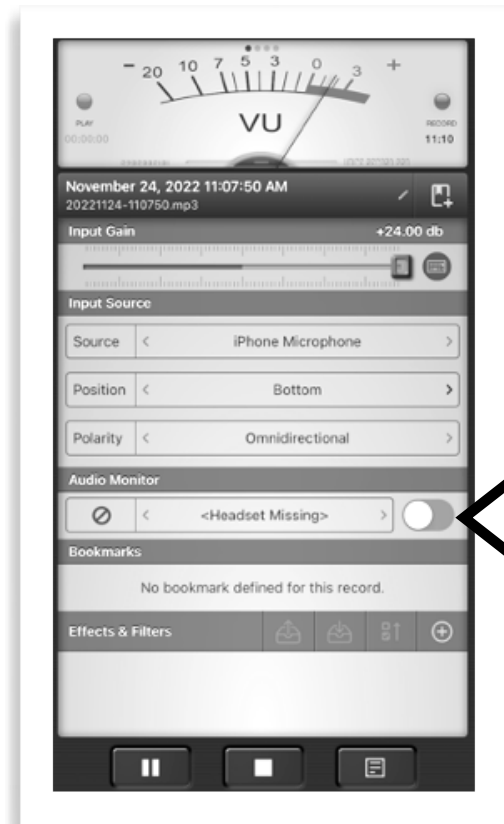


Always point the microphone to the person speaking.

It is a good idea to do a quick test recording before your interview.



You are now ready to record an interview!



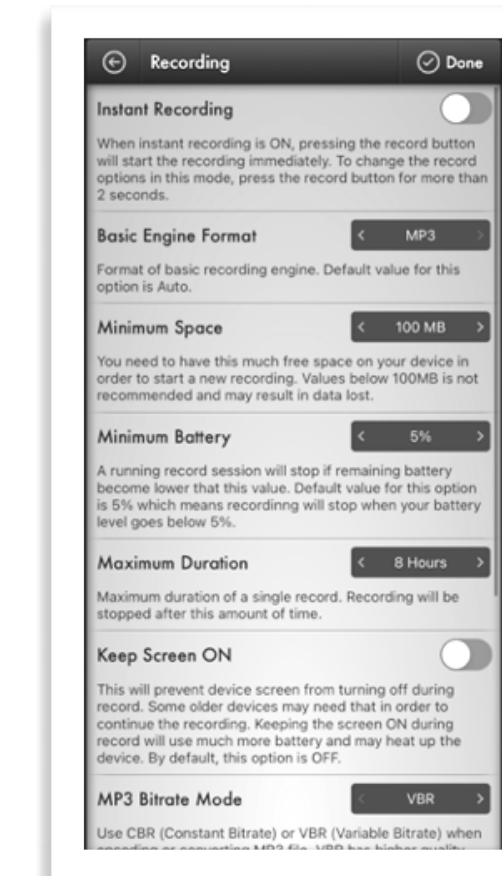
if you use headphones, connect them to the smartphone & click the white circle

When you finish the test recording, click the STOP button



If you wish to listen to your recording, press PLAY button

- Click '>' at 'Basic Engine Format'
- Keep doing this until you see MP3

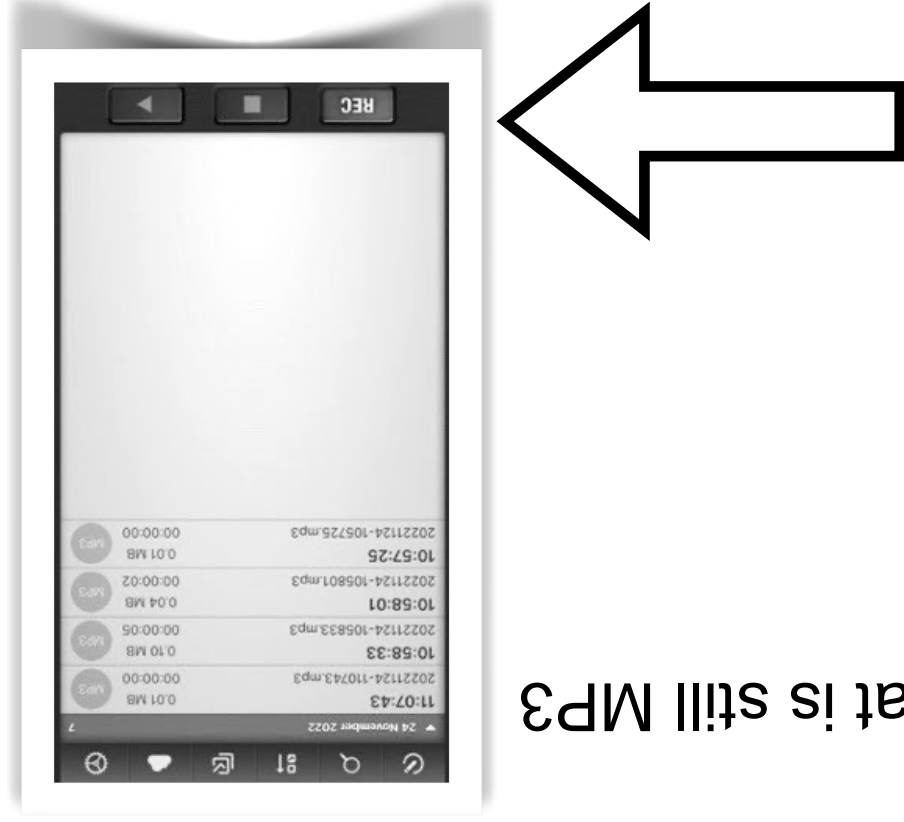


- Click 'Done'

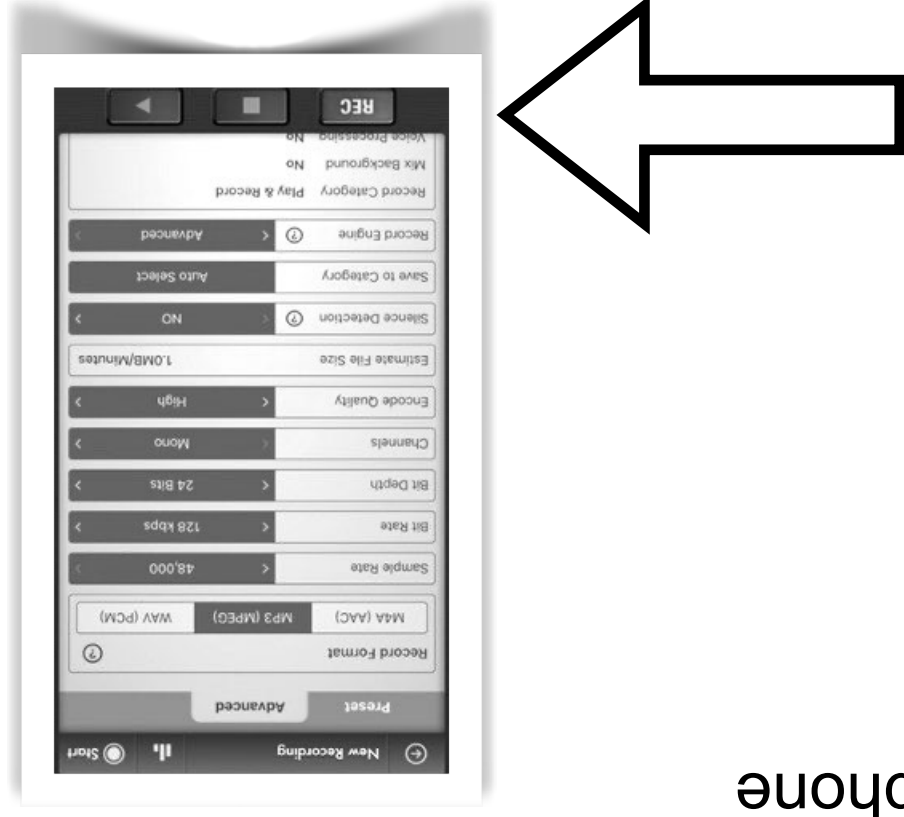
Let's record!

Click the 'REC' button.

Make sure the record format is still MP3



Click 'REC' again.
You are now recording audio!
Start talking to your smartphone



Become a pro!

The meter will help you to make a professional-sounding recording.

So watch the meter when making your test recording!

RED zone = BAD!

If the meter is too far to the left, move closer.



If the meter is in the red zone, move further away.
